We are pleased to announce that a new internship opportunity will be offered to APIEL students in cooperation with Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

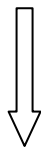
1. Program Description

The internship program is coordinated between APIEL and Sewage Business Management Center, under the JICA training course, “Sewage Works Engineering and Stormwater Drainage Technology”. The course offers training on planning, design, construction, maintenance and management of sewage works and stormwater drainage, and aims at advancement of problem solutions of the said issues at JICA trainees’ own countries. APIEL students will attend part of this JICA training course together with the JICA trainees, who are from more than 10 countries including Asian, African, Middle and South American, and east European countries. JICA trainees first submit their country reports, then those topics will be discussed in a workshop including APIEL students, followed by development of an action plan.
