1. Brief Job description

4. Competencies and requirements

- English command for business use
- Certain level of knowledge of Eco-industry is essential

- Being able to work for the whole assigned period

To make an application, send an email to apiel@env.t.u-tokyo.ac.jp, stating your name, affiliation, motivation statement of 350-400 words (MS Word format). Application must be submitted by the end of Thursday, August 20.

7. Selection

APIEL will shortlist applicants. ADBI then will conduct interview(s) and select 1-3 interns.

8. Credit

One credit will be given to those completed the internship programme.

Review will be done by ADBI and UT faculty member based on interns' work record and report from interns.

APIEL will not take any responsibility for any disbenefit caused by participation to the internship programme.

Interns should pay their travel and daily expenses during the internship period at their own cost.
